Mumbai, 27-28th February 2018

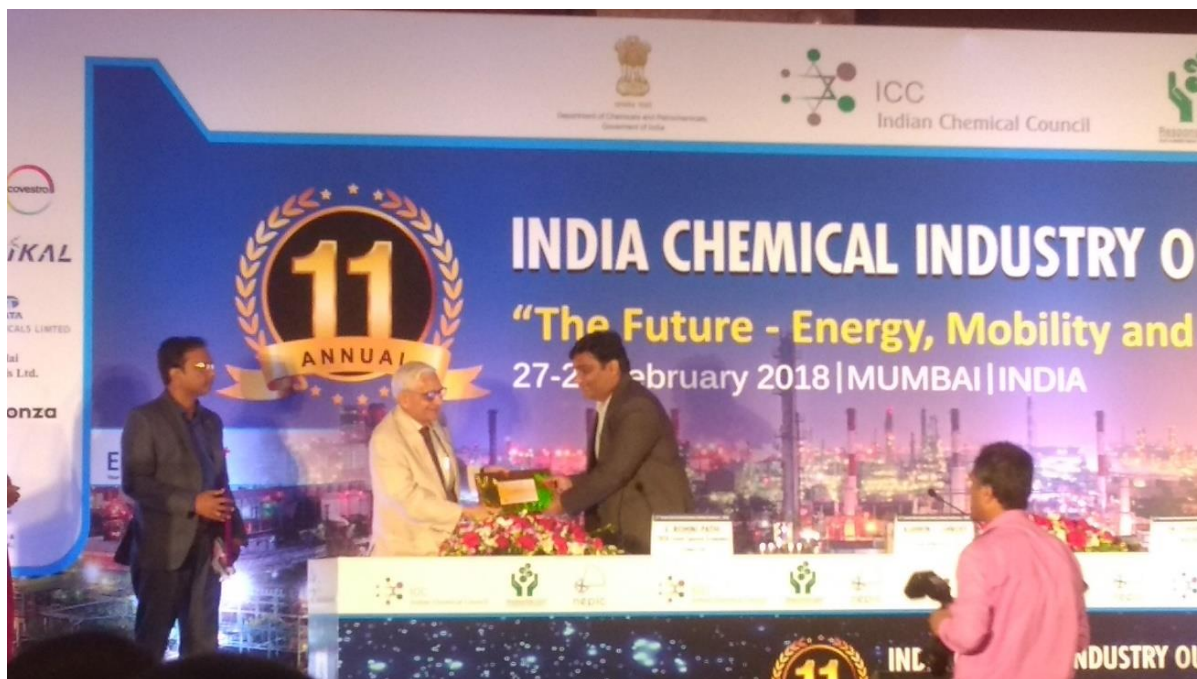
While speaking in ICC's 11th annual outlook conference, *Mr. E Rohini Pathi, Head-Strategic marketing of Tata Steel Special Economic Zone*, presented the enormous opportunities that **Gopalpur Industrial Park(GIP)** holds for chemical Industries. The conference was held in Grant Hyatt, Mumbai from 27th to 28th February 2018.

During his presentation, Mr. Rohini Introduced GIP to delegates, speakers and panel moderators who were attending the conference from across the globe and were keen to discuss the future investment opportunities that can be explored for chemical industry.

Other highlighting points from the presentation were:

- ❖ Availability of Petrochemical feedstock from PCPIR Paradeep, IOCL Refinery and HPCL Vizag- all located within 250 Kms of GIP
- ❖ Odisha holds huge promise for chemicals that go directly into metal industry such as Carbon, Soda ash, Manganese, Phosphorous and Sulfur etc.
- ❖ Proposed LNG pipeline to the industrial park by GAIL will ensure the low cost and clean energy for the chemical and petrochemical industry
- ❖ As GIP is in the final stages of Environmental Clearance, manufacturing units can save roughly around 12 to 14 months' time in setting up a new unit
